PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS

PARENTS:

1. Parents should be aware of their responsibility to make the stay of the visiting exchangee pleasant and educational.
2. Any difficulties with the exchange should be reported to the Club or Summer Exchange Chairman.
3. Rotarian hosts should encourage the exchangee to attend at least one Rotary meeting while he/she is in Canada.
4. The hosting family should arrange activities for their guest not only in the evening but also during the day.
5. The pocket money for students involved in this program should range between \$150 to \$200. Parents are responsible for their child's airfare.

STUDENTS:

1. Complete the application completely providing as much detail as possible to enable us to make the best match for your exchange.
2. The hosting student must **NOT** take employment that will interfere with his/her obligations to the guest.
3. If accepted, you will have the privilege of participating in an exceptional exchange program. It is your responsibility to be a good ambassador for your family and Rotary.
4. You are not permitted to drive a motor vehicle. The consequences of an accident would - regardless of fault and outcome - be disastrous for all concerned especially for your host family.
5. Drinking hard liquor is not allowed under this program. Beer and wine may be taken with the approval of the host parents in conformity with local laws.
6. In the event of an infraction of the rules, the students must agree to abide by the decision of the Rotary Committee even to the extent of being returned home at the parents' expense.
